# Fee Fie Foe Fum

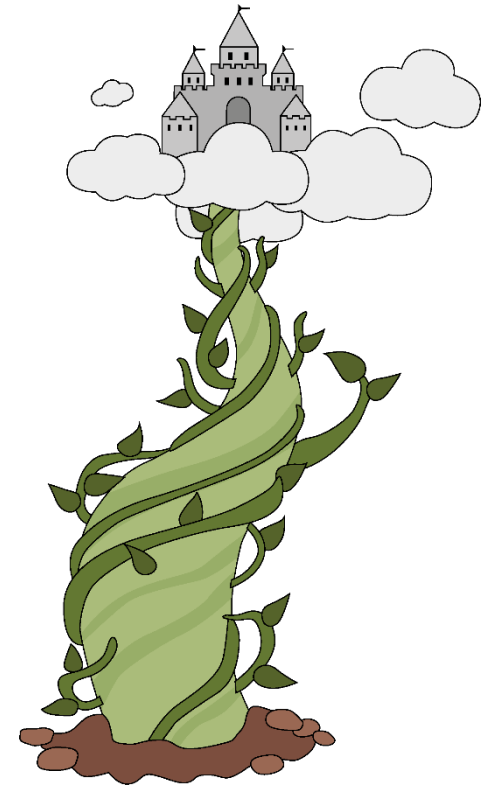
*Children can practice joining in with this rhyme during the repeated refrains in the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.*
